### **HOUSE REPUBLICANS DEPLORE DEMOCRATIC OFFICIALS SLAM OF POLICE**

#### ***HRA Calls Buckley Statements "Race Baiting"!***

The New Hampshire House Republican Alliance publicly denounces Ray Buckley- Vice Chairman of the NH Democratic Party for race baiting. While the majority of Americans view illegal immigration as a major problem that our country must address, Mr. Buckley dismisses the issue of illegality by attempting to politicize it into a racial issue. In a recent article in the Union Leader, Buckley states that the chiefs "are trying to scare the bejesus out of brown-skinned people who are minding their own business" and "That's exactly what has to be happening in Hudson and New Ipswich, it's not the situation that they happen to arbitrarily find them."

"Buckley's remarks are outright lies," stated Rep Cliff Newton. "Every month, police answer hundreds of calls for service, respond to accidents, and patrol to keep our towns and cities safe. Because New Ipswich and Hudson police apprehend and attempt to bring to justice ten illegal aliens in the course of that duty, Democrat leader Buckley accuses them of being racist."

Statistical information from the police records show that since January 1, 2005 New Ipswich has had 2008 calls for service and 976 motor vehicle stops and Hudson has had 21,148 calls for service and 7,638 motor vehicle stops.

The Alliance stands firmly behind the police chief's efforts for identifying individuals who have entered the United States illegally and is working diligently on the illegal immigration issue. Several pieces of legislation will be introduced this session. Among those being considered are stricter rules and stronger enforcement on employers who willingly hire illegal aliens, clarification of trespass laws and pressure on the federal government to better deal with illegal aliens who are apprehended in NH.

"For Mr. Buckley who represents the Democratic Party to resort to race-baiting is the lowest of lows," Cliff Newton said. "Certainly, New Hampshire Democrat leaders, including Governor Lynch and party leader Kathy Sullivan will also condemn Buckley's efforts at racial exploitation. If I were a Democrat Senator or State Representative and he was speaking for me, I would be looking for another voice or hoping for laryngitis."
