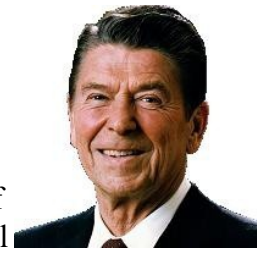


# HOUSE REPUBLICAN ALLIANCE RECOMMENDATION SHEET



“TRUST BUT VERIFY”

## THURSDAY, APRIL 11 PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS

**HB 25, making appropriations for capital improvements. OTP/A. Vote 18-0.**

**HRA Analysis:** This capital budget borrows every possible penny and spends it all. Maintenance and repairs of existing infrastructure is a legitimate government function.

**HRA Recommendation:** Vote your conscience.

## FINANCE

**HB 1, making appropriations for the expenses of certain departments of the state for fiscal years ending June 30, 2020 and June 30, 2021. Maj: OTP/A. Min: ITL. Vote 13-9.**

**HRA Analysis:** It's the budget, with a 13% increase over last year's, plus tax increases.

**HRA Recommendation:** Oppose the committee amendment, support Republican amendments (decreases), oppose Democrat amendments (increases), oppose OTP/A.

**HB 2, relative to state fees, funds, revenues, and expenditures. Maj: OTP/A. Min: ITL. Vote 13-9.**

**HRA Analysis:** It's the budget, with a 13% increase over last year's, plus tax increases.

**HRA Recommendation:** Oppose the committee amendment, support Republican amendments (decreases), oppose Democrat amendments (increases), oppose OTP/A.
