PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS

HB 115, repealing the allocation of gross appropriations from the highway fund. OTP/A. Vote 15-0.

HRA Analysis: This bill, as amended, simply adds two committee chairs to the list of people receiving a report on how the highway fund is budgeted. No Platform or Constitutional issues identified in the bill; the Constitutional authorization for uses of the highway fund is cited in the report statute.

HRA Recommendation: No Recommendation.

HB 144, establishing a commission to study the long-term viability of the state port authority. ITL. Vote 15-0.

HRA Analysis: This bill creates a study commission. No Platform or Constitutional issues identified.
