## HOUSE REPUBLICANS CALL FOR GOVERNOR TO INTERVENE ON ILLEGAL ALIEN TRESPASS CASE

## HRA Asks Governor Lynch to Instruct Attorney General to File Appeal

The NHHRA is requesting of the governor to take a strong proactive stand in support of the police and their efforts to provide public safety which includes curbing illegal immigration. The NHHRA asks Governor John Lynch to instruct Attorney General Kelly Ayotte to reconsider her stand not to appeal a district court judge's decision throwing out criminal trespass charges brought against illegal aliens by local police in New Ipswich and Hudson.

"It is vital to the safety of New Hampshire citizens that the flow of illegal immigration through NH be checked. Being a border state makes NH susceptible to infiltration by those entering illegally who could do harm," states Rep. Andrew Renzullo. "The recent report that Attorney General Kelly Ayotte will not take this case to the Supreme Court, calls for the governor to step up to the plate on this issue."

For more than a year, members of the NHHRA has been working on this issue and will be using the information gathered to introduce legislation in the upcoming session. Legislation will include clarifying criminal trespass laws, and enhancing penalties to employers who knowingly hire illegal aliens.

"I am disappointed that an issue that affects state rights was decided by a district court, a nonconstitutional court," stated Rep. Jordan Ulery. "It is vital that the governor instruct the attorney general to appeal this decision to a higher court where it belongs."
