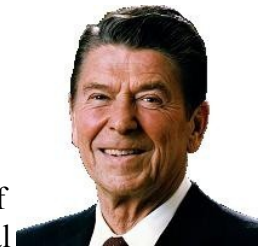


# HOUSE REPUBLICAN ALLIANCE RECOMMENDATION SHEET

## WEDNESDAY, April 3 REGULAR CALENDAR

### FINANCE

**HB 1-A**, making appropriations for the expenses of certain departments of the state for fiscal years ending June 30, 2014 and June 30, 2015. **MAJ:OTP/A. MIN: ITL. Vote 14-8.**

**HRA Analysis:** This bill increases state spending by more than 10%. The Platform, Part I, reiterates “low taxes are the result of low spending.”

**HRA Recommendation:** Support Republican amendments, oppose the committee amendment, oppose OTP/A.

**HB 2-FN-A-L**, relative to state fees, funds, revenues, and expenditures. **MAJ:OTP/A. MIN: ITL. Vote 14-8.**

**HRA Analysis:** This bill has all the law changes necessary for HB1, including the new and increased fees and taxes. The Platform, Part I, reiterates “low taxes are the result of low spending.”

**HRA Recommendation:** Support Republican amendments, oppose the committee amendment, oppose OTP/A.

### PUBLIC WORKS AND HIGHWAYS

**HB 25-FN-A**, making appropriations for capital improvements. **OTP/A. Vote 19-0.**

**HRA Analysis:** This bill, as amended, borrows funds for maintenance and facility upgrades throughout the state. No constitutional or platform issues.

**HRA Recommendation:** No Recommendation.
