
Bills Amended by Senate Recommendation Sheet

HB185, (Third New Title) relative to the determination of parental rights and responsibilities based on shared parenting and requiring all municipalities and school governing bodies to post on their official website the amount of funds received by the state either by allocation or grant.

HRA Analysis: Adds in SB134 (disability pensions, new landfill permits) and SB532 (posting amount of funds received from state, deferring inspection of new vehicles, titles of vehicles over 20 years old).

This is a priority to pass shared parenting time, we've been trying for over a decade

HRA Recommendation: Concur

HB1006, relative to creating a family access motion for the enforcement of parenting plans.

HRA Analysis: Clarifies this motion with expedited timeline can only be used for substantial breaches of parenting time. Regular non-contempt motion can still be filed with the current standard timeline for non-substantial, just as they are today.

HRA Analysis: Senate attempted a compromise by requiring parental book complaint process to require school board written explaination of whether the material has been determined to be harmful to minors, age-inappropriate, or otherwise offensive. However, problem remains that materials cannot be removed on the basis of the author or of viewpoint that opens the door for school board to reject any parental complaint. Does not even make a bad bill better.

HRA Analysis: Amendment removes the entire point of the bill, to enable the SoS to conduct a second recount after an election, based on what happened with Infantine's recount.

HB1596, requiring a disclosure of deceptive artificial intelligence usage in political advertising.

HRA Analysis: Minor changes **HRA Recommendation:** Concur

HB468, (New Title) establishing a commission to recodify the education laws and making an appropriation therefor.

HRA Analysis: Turns the bill into a study commission to propose changes

HRA Recommendation: Request C of C

CACR13, relating to slavery and involuntary servitude. Providing that slavery and involuntary servitude shall be prohibited in the state of New Hampshire.

HRA Analysis: The Senate improved the measure by replacing the original CACR language with the exact U.S. 13th Amendment language. That language has well developed case law to guide judges' rulings. The original language has no case law behind it, which leaves interpretation wide open to a judge's discretion.

HB1573, (Third New Title) relative to out-of-home placements for children.

HRA Analysis: Replace House version with bad Senate version.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1241, (New Title) relative to the regulation of money transmitters and relative to license applications and renewals for certain consumer credit entities.

HRA Analysis: Appears to have SB553 NH Investment added, House sent to IS

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1243, (New Title) revising the laws relative to retail installment sales of motor vehicles, and relative to the sale of a vehicle to a Massachusetts resident.

HRA Analysis: Adds SB510 - House attached 2 important car inspection bills to this pro-dealer

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1259, (New Title) relative to property and casualty insurance laws administered by the insurance department; and making an appropriation to the department of environmental services to fund regional drinking water infrastructure.

HRA Analysis: Adds SB393 - House dramatically cut funding levels, this infrastructure investment

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1358, (Second New Title) relative to tenant and contract manufacturers of beer, wine, and liquor; allowing pharmacists to administer influenza, COVID-19, and other FDA licensed vaccines without explicit approval from the general court; and, restricting the purchase of real property on or around military installations.

HRA Analysis: Adds in SB366 (Chinese land restrictions, ITL) and SB402 (pharmacist vax, we added 3 vax bills).

HB1380, (New Title) relative to brew pub licenses, relative to insurance cost-sharing calculations, and relative to receipt of pharmaceutical rebates by insurers and pharmacy benefits managers.

HRA Analysis: Adds in SB354 and SB555.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB318, (Third New Title) relative to bail commissioners, the standards applicable to and the administration of bail, and making an appropriation.

HRA Analysis:

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1195, relative to allowing school districts to approve different apportionment methods for school administrative unit costs.

HRA Analysis: The Senate changes the voting method which opens the door for a larger district within the SAU to out vote all the smaller districts.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1265, (New Title) relative to the penalty for failure to file school expenditure reports, relative to certain adequacy grants, and requiring mandatory reporting by school districts of school expenses.

HRA Analysis: The Senate amended the bill with SB219, which requires information on cost per pupil and administrators be made available prior to the budget vote. Some definition issues in it that need correction.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1298, relative to the definition of part-time teachers.

HRA Analysis: Senate removed some requirements for a part-time teacher that are problematic.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1616, (New Title) relative to parental consent for student participation in Medicaid to schools program and establishing a pilot recruitment and retention program within the department of health and human services.

HRA Analysis: Senate added amendment for the DHHS pilot program.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1665, (New Title) relative to student eligibility for education freedom accounts and the scholarship organization's costs of administering the program, extending phase-out grants for education freedom accounts, and revising the definitions of average daily membership in attendance and average daily membership in residence.

HRA Analysis: Senate reduced the family income cap from 500% of fed poverty to 400%. They also extended the current phase out grants to districts when student leaves for an EFA for an added 3 years, EFA student payments for public school classes from state rather than from their EFA, reduces CSF administrative fee from 10% to 8%.

HB1695, relative to the release of student personally identifiable information.

HB463, (New Title) relative to the establishment of an election information portal and makes an appropriation therefor.

HRA Analysis: We need to kill this bill, it is a big election integrity issue to have people registering to vote and requesting absentee ballots online

HB1091, relative to the financing of political campaigns.

HRA Analysis: We passed similar changes in a dupliciative SB

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1313, relative to access to the voter checklist by candidates.

HRA Analysis:

HB1369, relative to the verification of voter rolls every 4 years.

HRA Analysis: Changes the first verification from 2027 to 2025 and changes voted in the last 4 years, to voted in the last 6 years.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1370, (New Title) relative to eliminating voter identification exceptions.

HRA Analysis: We already got this bill in the original House form as HB1569

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1386, relative to prohibiting the disposal of lithium-ion batteries in solid waste landfill facilities, composting facilities, or incinerators.

HRA Analysis: minor changes to definitions

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB518, (New Title) relative to the administration of occupations by the office of professional licensure and certification. **HRA Analysis:** Adds SB485, which was passed but treed to add HB1111- false DCYF reports. (if the underlying bill isn't a

priority, we should non-concur to try to get HB1111, but will defer to Chair on that)

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1079, (Second New Title) relative to critical incident stress management team members and establishing a rural and underserved area educator incentive program for higher education and making an appropriation therefor.

HRA Analysis: Adds in SB217 which was killed by House Rs.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1521, (New Title) relative to recovery houses.

HRA Analysis: Adds limit of 0.4% of population for recovery houses.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1622, relative to administrative rulemaking and license renewals by the office of professional licensure and certification.

HRA Analysis:

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1278, (New Title) relative to qualifying medical conditions for purposes of therapeutic cannabis; and relative to the summer EBT program, the SNAP elderly simplified application and the school lunch program and making appropriations therefor.

HRA Analysis: Adds in SB599 (vax=biologics) and SB499 (free food for all!) to a bill to expand therapeutic access.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1585, (Third New Title) relative to the position of certified assisted living medication aide and relative to the state loan repayment program for qualified nursing professionals, and making an appropriation therefor.

HRA Analysis: Adds in SB456 - Nurse loan forgiveness which House ITL. CALMA is medication administration assistant, new category, to let someone help with taking low risk meds.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1593, (New Title) making an appropriation to the department of health and human services to support recreational activities for individuals with developmental disabilities.

HRA Analysis: Adds SB497, a major change in how funds are sent to hospitals. While this had a NGA hearing in the Senate, this is too big a change to accept without proper review by the House.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1069, (New Title) relative to material subject to disclosure under the right-to-know law.

HRA Analysis: Bill is needed, but we need to change wording a bit. We want media to be able to get records, even if out of state, but we don't need China to be requesting bulk data at taxpayer expense.

HB1274, relative to judicial administration.

HRA Analysis: Amendment just adds one line to exclude assistant director for safety and security of the judicial branch from the part-time retirement definition.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1030, (New Title) repealing certain task forces, study committees, and study commissions, repealing the John G. Winant memorial commission and making the maintenance of the memorial a duty of the joint legislative historical committee, and establishing a committee to study the appeals process administered by the environmental councils established under RSA 21-O.

HB1223, (New Title) creating local options for games of chance.

HRA Analysis: Need to rework effective date and improve wording elsewhere. Senate in agreement with COC.

HB1202, (New Title) relative to the issuance of permits for the alteration of driveways exiting onto public ways and relative to the definition of disability or special needs under the child care scholarship program.

HB2024, (Third New Title) relative to the state 10-year transportation improvement plan; relative to adding a speed limit of 45 miles per hour on rural highways; relative to disability pensions for public safety employees who are victims of violence; and making a capital appropriation to the department of corrections toward the replacement of the New Hampshire state prison for men.

HRA Analysis: Adds in SB134 (treed with HB1620), SB471 (tabled) and SB476 (passed with red flag law treed on).

HB1623, (New Title) relative to involuntary retirement or decommissioning of electricity generators.

HRA Analysis: Gutted the thrust of energy resilience provision - Non-concur

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1400, (Third New Title) relative to residential parking spaces, landlord-tenant law, unauthorized occupant evictions, and zoning procedures concerning residential housing.

HRA Analysis: Omnibus bill adds several including SB538 which was killed by all but 7 R's along with many D's. Contains several parts of which a couple can not pass.

HRA Recommendation: House already (in recess) requested CofC

HB1127, (New Title) relative to the revocation and suspension of drivers' licenses and to invalidating out-of-state driver's licenses issued to undocumented immigrants.

HRA Analysis: Adds in SB358, which was killed by dems and 4 House Rs.
