HOUSE REPUBLICAN ALLIANCE ELECTS LEADERSHIP FOR 2025-2026

Concord, NH –The House Republican Alliance (HRA) has elected new tri-chairs for the 2025-2026 legislative session.

Established in 1997 by former House conservative Paul Mirski, the House Republican Alliance (HRA) is a Republican caucus of state representatives dedicated to upholding the New Hampshire and U.S. Constitutions, and traditional GOP values. The HRA's primary goal is to keep the Republican Party focused on these principles when evaluating all proposed legislation prior to each House session. Their recommendations are then shared with the caucus via a 'pink sheet'. The HRA works to make NH the best place for people to live.

Representative JD Bernardy, R-South Hampton, will serve his second term as co-chair. Bernardy emphasized the importance of responsible budgeting in light of declining state revenues. "We understand our responsibility, the need to simultaneously live within our means as well as the need to create a budget that protects the Granite Stators", Bernardy said.

Joining Bernardy are newcomers Representative Katelyn Kuttab, R-Windham, who is entering her second term and Representative Kevin Scully, R-Nashua, another second-term member.

All three co-chairs have been actively involved with the HRA and possess extensive experience in policy and procedure. In their new roles, they pledge to promote legislation that serves the best interests of all New Hampshire citizens, including supporting a responsible state budget that avoids burdening taxpayers.

The incoming co-chairs expressed gratitude to the outgoing co-chairs, Deb Hobson and JR Hoell, for their work over the past two years.
